**Freedom of information request:** Reference 22-134

I refer to your application made under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the FOI Act) that was received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 4 October 2022. It is my understanding that you are seeking access to the following information:

*A traffic monitoring device was installed on Sheaffe Street Holder, 8 Sept 2022. I want access to documents that relate to: 1) the owner of the device 2) who authorised the installation of this device on Sheaffe St 3) who requested installation of this device on Sheaffe St 4) the planning or traffic management purpose of installing the device and the data it provided 5) any request for tender or statement of requirement for traffic modelling, impact analysis or planning assessment related to the installation of this device or the data it generated 6) any traffic modelling or impact analysis or assessment related to the installation of this device or the data it generated.*

On 1 November 2022, I made a decision on your application, in which it was determined that no relevant information was held by TCCS.

I thank you for your feedback on 3 November 2022, including a photo of the device relevant to your request. Following your feedback, an additional search of records held by TCCS was completed. In accordance with section 32(2) of the FOI Act, this notice is related to additional information identified in the additional search.

**Authority**

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

**Decision on access**

A secondary search of information held by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) has been undertaken and seven records have been identified as relevant to your access request.

As detailed in the following statement of reasons, I have decided to provide you with partial access to these records.

A list of the records identified as relevant to your application is enclosed at [Attachment A](#). A copy of the records, with deletions applied to information that is contrary to the public interest, is enclosed at [Attachment B](#).

## **Statement of Reasons**

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act; and
- The *Human Rights Act 2016*.

In making my decision on disclosing the relevant government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 and 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies.

### **Schedule 1:**

- No relevant sections identified.

### **Schedule 2:**

#### ***Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Section 2.1)***

- Schedule 2.1(a)(i) - promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability;
- Schedule 2.2(a)(iii) - inform the community of the government's operations, including the policies, guidelines and codes of conduct followed by the government in its dealings with members of the community; and
- Schedule 2.1(a)(viii) - reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision.

#### ***Factors favouring non-disclosure (Section 2.2)***

- Schedule 2.2(a)(ii) - prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2016*; and
- Schedule 2.2(a)(xi) - prejudice trade secrets, business affairs or research of an agency or person.

In reviewing the relevant records, personal information relating to third parties, including information which is likely to identify a third party, has been identified.

I have considered that this information is not readily available to the public and the disclosure of this information is likely to prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy under the *Human Rights Act 2004* and carries significant weight. In this instance, I have found the disclosure of personal information to be, on balance, contrary to the public interest.

Further, I have identified information showing a methodology of costings for third party services. I have found that disclosing information is, on balance, contrary to the public interest as disclosure is likely to prejudice business affairs by making itemised costs known to potential competitors.

I have found that the factors favouring disclosure can be satisfied with the deletion of information which is contrary to the public interest. A copy of the relevant information is enclosed at Attachment B.

In relation to part 5 of your application, no records were identified. This is due to the installation of the device being part of an existing contract for the provision of traffic data collection services, reference 30230-NCT-100. A copy of the contract is available [here](#).

### **Charges**

Pursuant to *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2018* processing charges are applicable where more than 50 pages are disclosed. No fee is applicable to your application, as the total number of pages is within the fee free threshold.

### **Disclosure log**

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application and my decision will be published on the TCCS disclosure between 3 – 10 days after the date of this decision.

### **Ombudsman review**


