I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), which was received by Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate (TCCS) on 20 March 2023 seeking access to the following government information:

"Copies of all records and information that the Directorate has provided to the ACT Ombudsman in relation to matter 2021-102423."

Timeframes

TCCS is required to provide a decision on your access application by 19 April 2023.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Decision on access

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search has been completed of TCCS records and relevant information has been identified. In reviewing the information in scope of your application, I have found that disclosure of these records is deemed to be contrary to the public interest under schedule 1.

Information in possession of the Ombudsman - Schedule 1 section 1.12

Schedule 1 to the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the FOI Act) sets out information the disclosure of which is taken to be contrary to the public interest. Schedule 1 section 1.12(b) provides that information in the possession of the Ombudsman that has been obtained or generated in relation to an investigation undertaken by the Ombudsman under the *Ombudsman Act 1989*, section 9, is information the disclosure of which is taken to be contrary to the public interest.

The information you are seeking has been identified as records obtained or generated in relation to an investigation undertaken by the Ombudsman under section 9 of the *Ombudsman Act 1989.* I am required on this basis to refuse disclosure of the information identified in the possession of the Ombudsman as it is taken to be contrary to the public interest under schedule 1 of the FOI Act.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request.

Online publishing – disclosure log

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your access application and this notice of decision will be published on the disclosure log within 3 - 10 business days. Your personal information will be removed from these documents prior to publication.

Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in TCCS' disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.
