EXISTING ELEMENTS

- Existing Asphalt Path
Shared pedestrian and cycle path to remain
- 1** Existing Rock and Headwall Structure
Creek infrastructure and rock work retained
- 2** Existing Grass Swale
Vegetated corridor conveying stormwater through the site
- 3** Existing Asphalt to be retained
Retained pavement forming part of the movement network
- 4** Existing Trees to be retained
Established trees retained and opportunity for Landcare group and community engagement

PROPOSED ELEMENTS

- Proposed Pedestrian Path
New path providing pedestrian access through the site
- Play Space Area with Softfall Organic Mulch
Active play zone with mulch and coloured rubber softfall, incorporating ninja course elements (crazy crossing, parallel bars, monkey trail, balance rail, pommel bridge, rope net climber, step boxes)
- Canoe Swing
Group Swing play element, and seating opportunity
- Picnic Area
Picnic area with natural shade for informal gathering
- Future Stage Public Toilet
Site identified for future amenities building - with water drinking fountain amenity
- Future Stage Pedestrian Path, not currently funded
New path providing pedestrian access through the site
- 1** Vehicle Gate
Maintenance and controlled vehicle access with directional marker
- 2** Interactive Painted Artwork
Painted asphalt artwork motif of Ginninderra Creek, provides play element
- 3** Table Setting
Picnic opportunity within the park setting
- 4** FRP Foot Bridge with Safety Kickrail
Pedestrian crossing enabling connection over grass swale
- B1** Vehicle Barriers
Mix of Natural rock and sandstone block visual vehicle barriers
- S1** Sandstone Block - Seating
Informal seating with opportunity for artistic carving
- S2** Rock Boulder Edge - Seating
Edge treatment that provides visual aesthetics for the natural setting of the park and informal seating

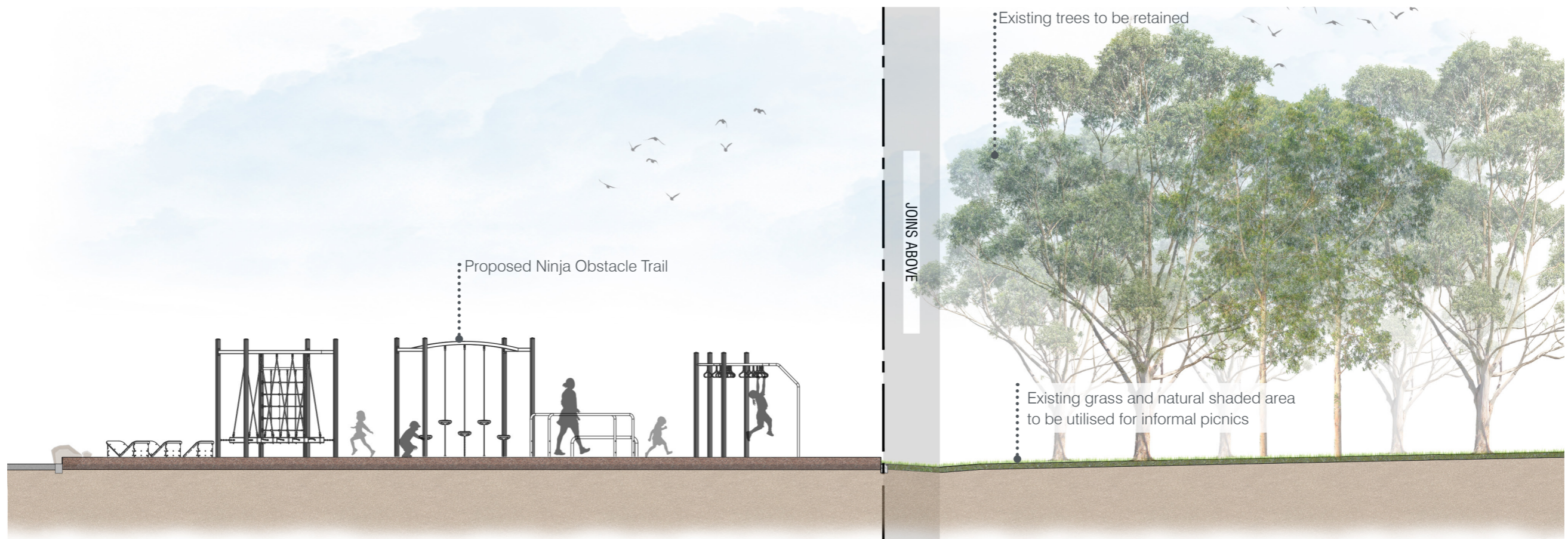
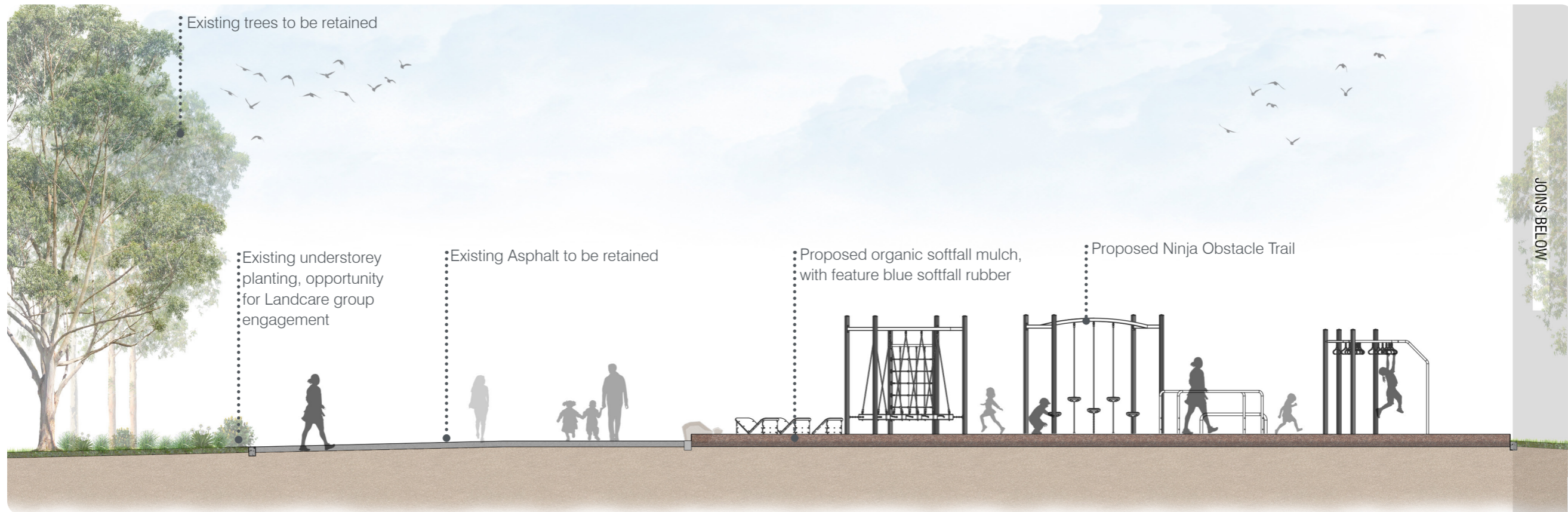

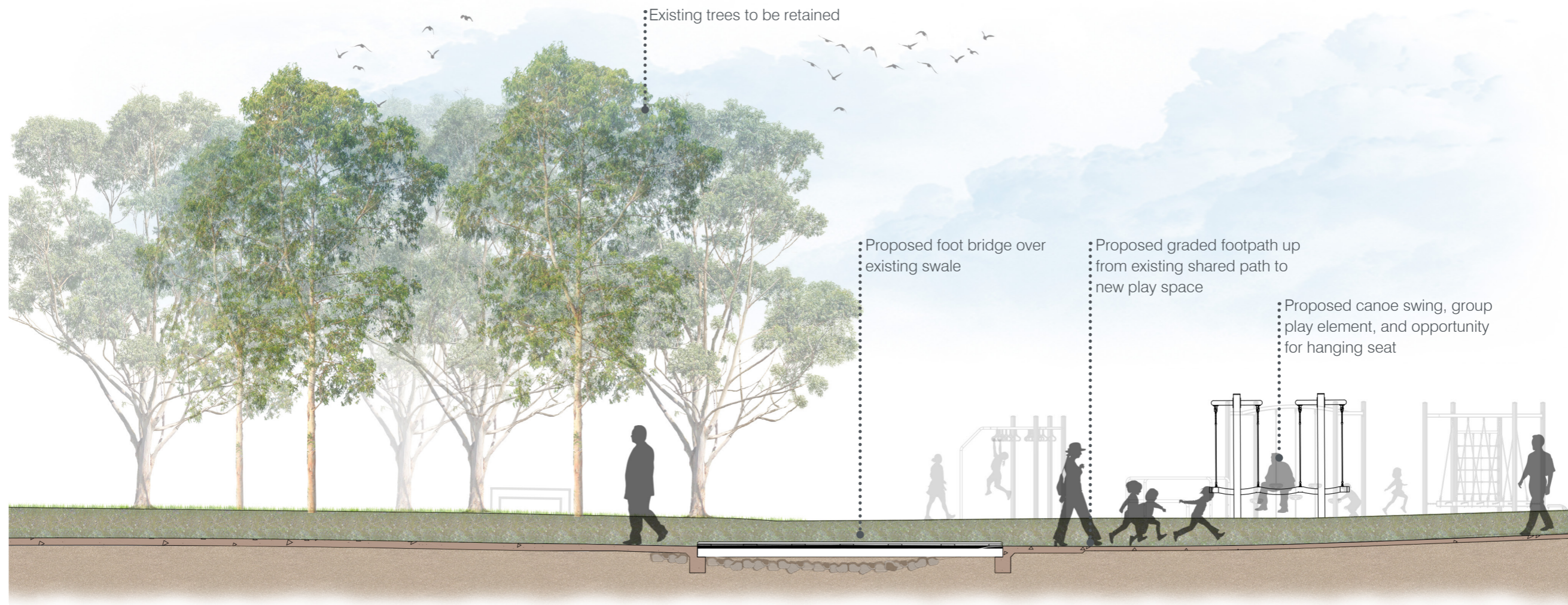

Proposed canoe swing, group play element, and opportunity for hanging seat

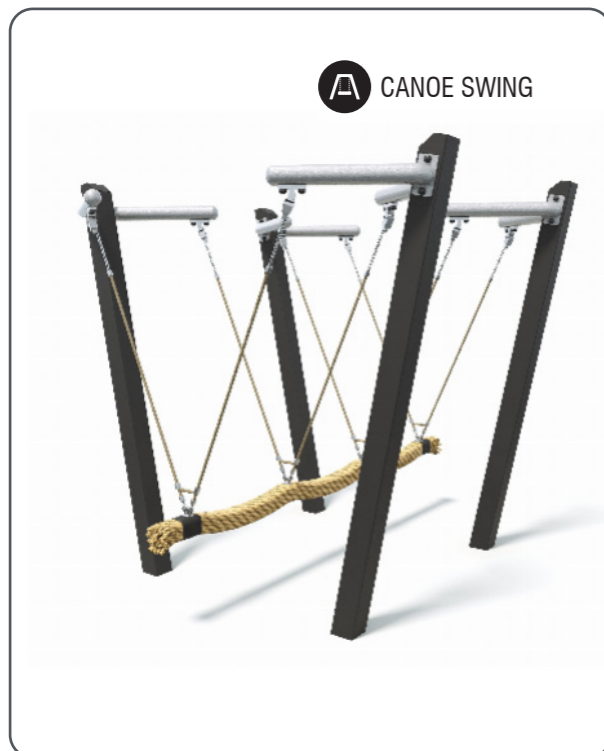
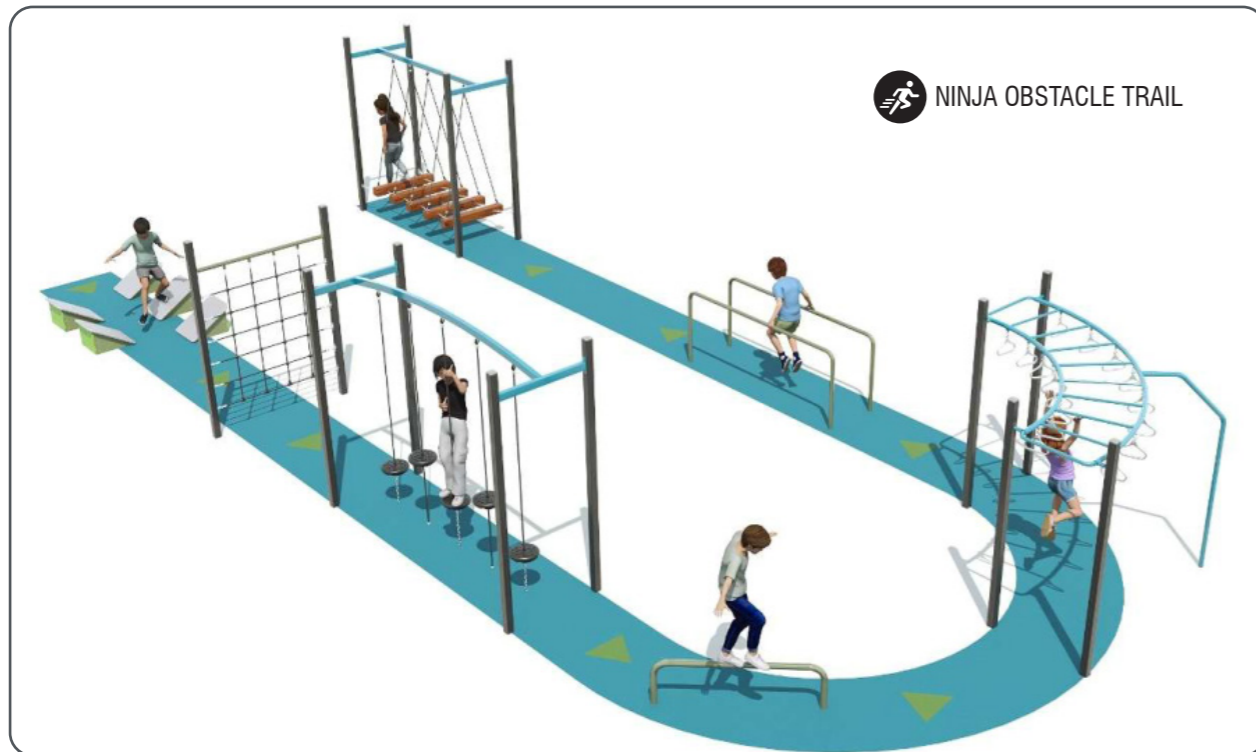

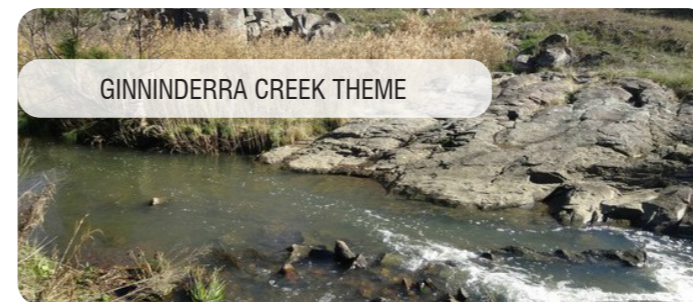
