

# What goes in your household bins?

## Landfill

The landfill bin is for household items that can't be recycled or reused.



### Don't place these items in the landfill bin:

- ✗ hazardous materials (like batteries or chemicals)
- ✗ e-waste
- ✗ building waste
- ✗ garden waste
- ✗ hot ash

These items should be taken elsewhere for recycling or safe disposal.

## Recycling

The recycling bin is for empty household containers, packaging, paper and cardboard.



### Don't place these items in the recycling bin:

- ✗ recycling in plastic bags
- ✗ soft plastics such as chip packets and cling wrap
- ✗ broken ceramic or glass kitchenware
- ✗ clothing and bulky items

## Green waste

The green waste bin is for garden organic waste such as weeds, grass clippings, flowers, leaves, prunings and small branches.



### Don't place these items in the green waste bin:

- ✗ food waste
- ✗ garbage
- ✗ compostable and plastic bags
- ✗ animal waste
- ✗ logs, stumps or treated timber
- ✗ soil
- ✗ fruit on branches
