Freedom of information request: Reference 20-044 and 20-046

I refer to the access applications made under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the FOI Act) by you and received by Transport Canberra and City Services directorate (TCCS) on 17 June 2020. In your applications, you sought access to:

- 20-044: “all documents relating to the decision to install bus stop 1815 in Bonython including any representations from the public about it” (see [Attachment A](#)); and
- 20-046: “all documents regarding consideration of moving bus routes 78 and 81 from Scollay St to Anketell St up to Soward Way.”

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

Under section 84 of the Act, if a decision is made under section 82(1) on an Ombudsman review, you may apply to the ACAT for review of the Ombudsman decision.


