### Freedom of Information Request - Reference 23-018

I refer to your application for access to government information received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) by transfer from the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate on 6 March 2023. It is my understanding that you are seeking access to the following government information under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act):

*"I would like the: - number of fix my street requests raised for dumped rubbish/furniture - the date they were raised/submitted to the government - from 1 November 2022 to present - for the addresses/locations that contain numbers "Ijong Street" and/or "Devenport" or "Davenport" - if it is an extractable field - also the comment/description of the dumped rubbish/furniture that was reported."*

### Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the FOI Act, TCCS is required to decide on your application by 4 April 2023.

### Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

### Decision on access

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search of TCCS records has been completed and the relevant information extracted to a format consistent with your request. A copy of this record is enclosed at [Attachment A](#).

While information in the comments field has been extracted some lines may appear to be incomplete. This is a result of a character limit in our system.

Upon reviewing the information within this record and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have found it to be in the public interest to provide you with full access. The reasons for my decision are detailed below in the statement of reasons.

## Statement of Reasons

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act, including the public interest test and pro-disclosure principles; and
- The *Human Rights Act 2016*.

In making my decision on disclosing the relevant government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 and 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies.

### **Schedule 1:**

- No relevant sections identified.

### **Schedule 2:**

#### **Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Schedule 2.1)**

- Schedule 2.1(a)(i) - promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability;
- Schedule 2.1(a)(iv) - ensure effective oversight of expenditure of public funds.

#### **Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2.2)**

- No relevant factors identified.

In reviewing the information within scope of your application, I have identified information that is likely to contribute to an effective oversight of expenditure of public funds. Further, I acknowledge that disclosure may promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance government's accountability generally.

In my review, no factors in schedule 1 or schedule 2.2 have been identified as relevant. In accordance with section 17 of the FOI Act, I find the disclosure of the information at Attachment A in the public interest.

## Charges

In accordance with [Freedom of Information \(Fees\) Determination 2018](#), a fee of \$0.35 per page of information disclosed, except for the first 50 pages, may be applied to an access application. As the total number of pages to be disclosed is within this fee-free threshold, no fee is applicable.

## Online publishing – disclosure log

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application, my decision and documents will be published in the TCCS disclosure log between 3 – 10 business days from the date of this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published. You may view the TCCS' disclosure log [here](#).

## Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek an Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in TCCS' disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.
