### Timeframes

A decision is due on your access application by 24 October 2023.

### Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

### Decision on access

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search of TCCS records has been completed and four records have been identified as relevant to your application. The records identified as relevant to your application are listed in the schedule enclosed at [Attachment A](#). A copy of these records is enclosed at [Attachment B](#).

Upon reviewing the information within this record and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have found it to be in the public interest to provide you with full access. The reasons for my decision are detailed below in the statement of reasons.

### Statement of Reasons

In making my decision on disclosing the relevant government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 and 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies. I have also taken the following into account:

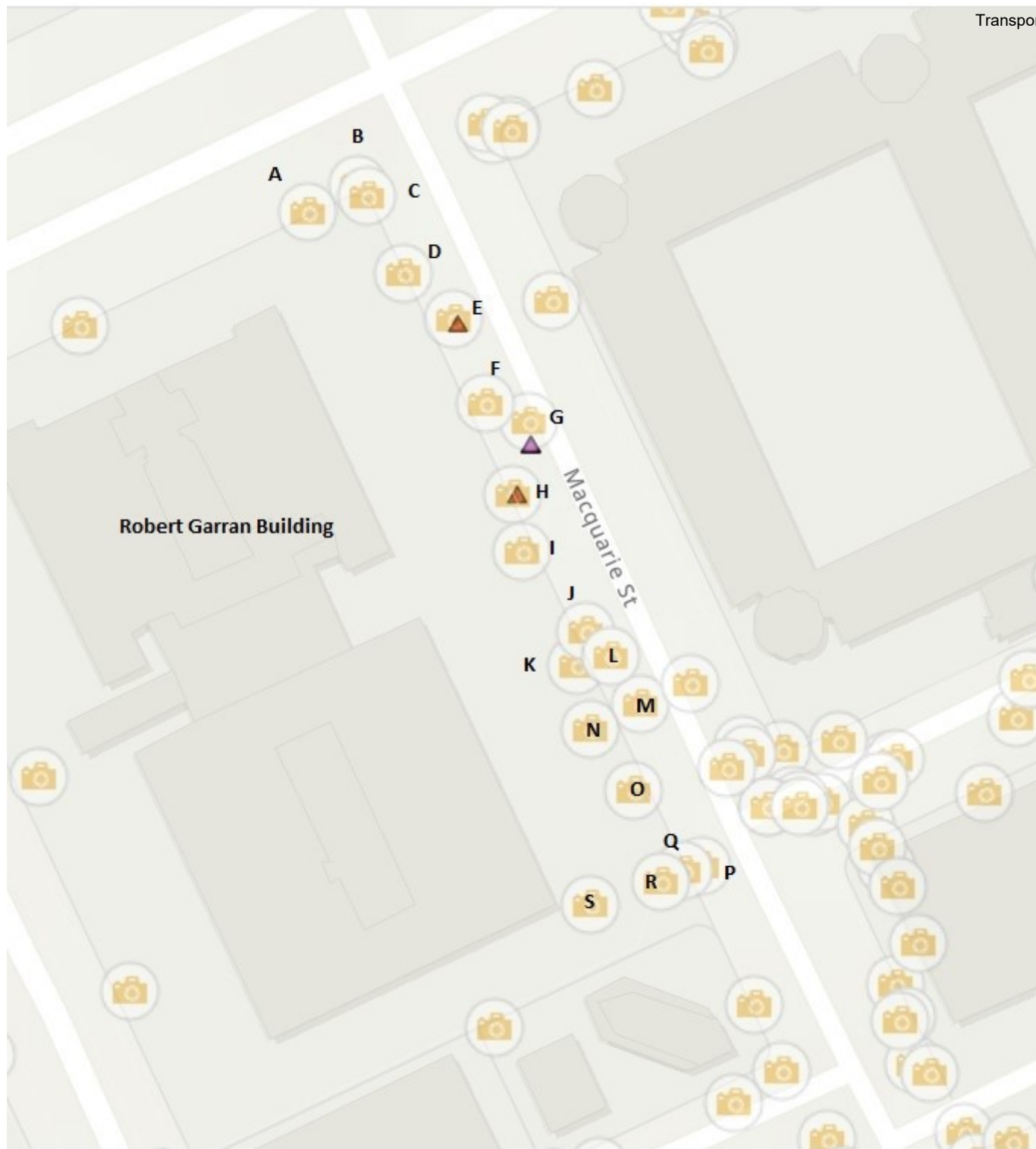
