Or any reports re the footpath conditions (uneven surfaces, leaf litter), on Macquarie Street Barton, near intersection with Kings Avenue, Outside Robert Garran Building"

I thank you for clarifying the timeframe on of documents relevant to your application on 11 September 2023:

"for last 2 years please".

#### **Timeframes**

A decision is due on your access application by 24 October 2023.

#### **Authority**

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

#### **Decision on access**

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search of TCCS records has been completed and four records have been identified as relevant to your application. The records identified as relevant to your application are listed in the schedule enclosed at <u>Attachment A.</u> A copy of these records is enclosed at <u>Attachment B.</u>

Upon reviewing the information within this record and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have found it to be in the public interest to provide you with full access. The reasons for my decision are detailed below in the statement of reasons.

#### **Statement of Reasons**

In making my decision on disclosing the relevant government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 and 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies. I have also taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act; and
- The Human Rights Act 2016.

In reviewing the information within scope of your application, I have identified information that is likely to reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision. Further, I acknowledge that disclosure may promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance government's accountability generally.

In my review, no factors in schedule 1 or schedule 2.2 have been identified as relevant. In accordance with section 17 of the FOI Act, I find the disclosure of the information at Attachment B in the public interest.

#### Charges

In accordance with <u>Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2018</u>, a fee of \$0.35 per page of information disclosed, except for the first 50 pages, may be applied to an access application. No fees are applicable to this application as the number of pages being released are within the fee-free threshold.
