Freedom of Information – Notice of Decision

I refer to your application under section 30 of the [Freedom of Information Act 2016](#) (the FOI Act), received by the City and Environment Directorate (CED) on 3 September 2025. Your application was received by partial transfer from the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD). A separate decision on your application in relation to information held in CMTEDD has been provided to you. It is my understanding you are seeking access to the following information:

- 1. The final draft version of answers to questions on notice and questions taken on notice concerning any ACT Public Service Directorate from the 2025-26 Legislative Assembly Budget Estimates hearings that were provided to any ACT Minister's office for review, comment, or approval.*
- 2. All correspondence and advice between any staff member of any ACT Public Service Directorate and any Minister or member of a Minister's office staff where they have requested amendments, alterations, or proposed changes to the draft answers identified in Part 1. In relation to this point, you are [the applicant is] seeking any request for amendment from the Minister and/or their staff.*

I thank you for providing the following context in your application:

- The intention of the request is for drafts sent from the directorate to the minister's office, and then amended drafts returned to the directorate from the minister's office. Noting that this may happen a few times for the same response.*

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the FOI Act, CED was required to provide a decision on your access application within 30 working days, being 15 October 2025. I thank you for agreeing to additional time to make a decision until 4 December 2025.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of the City and Environment Directorate under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

Decision on access

A search for CED records has been completed and 162 records within the scope of your application have been identified. The records are listed in the schedule at **Attachment A**.

I have decided to:

- grant **full** access to 145 records.
- grant **partial** access to 17 records.

The reasons for my decision are detailed in the *statement of reasons* section below. Please note that some information has also been redacted as it falls outside of the scope of your application. The records being released to you are provided at **Attachment B** with redactions applied to any information contrary to the public interest to release.

Statement of reasons

The FOI Act has a pro-disclosure bias, which requires information to be disclosed unless doing so would be contrary to the public interest. As an Information Officer, I am responsible for determining whether disclosure of the information within the scope of your application would be contrary to the public interest.

My assessment begins with Schedule 1 of the FOI Act, which outlines categories of information that are taken to be contrary to the public interest to disclose. If the information does not fall within any of these categories, I must then apply the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act. This test involves weighing the factors favouring disclosure against those favouring nondisclosure, as set out in Schedule 2.

In reaching my access decisions, I have taken the following into account:

- the FOI Act
- the information that falls within the scope of your application
- the *Human Rights Act 2004*
- the ACT Ombudsman FOI Guidelines

I confirm that I have not considered any of the factors listed in section 17(2) of the FOI Act, which outlines a list of considerations that must not be taken into account when applying the public interest test.

Schedule 1 – Information taken to be contrary to the public interest

- *Section 1.6 - Cabinet Information.*

In my review, I identified some information in records 118, 119, 127 and 128 to contain information which contains an information relating to a cabinet deliberation, which if disclosed would reveal the details of a deliberation of Cabinet. This information is not purely factual. As such, I have found schedule 1, section 1.6 applies, in which disclosure is deemed to be contrary to the public interest to disclose. As this factor only applies to part of the information within these records, I have considered the public interest in disclosing remaining information under the public interest test, which is detailed below.

Schedule 2 – Public interest test

Factors favouring disclosure (Schedule 2.1)

- *Section 2.1(a)(i) - promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability.*

- *Section 2.1(a)(ii) - contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest.*
- *Section 2.1(a)(iv) - ensure effective oversight of expenditure of public funds*

The 2025-26 Legislative Assembly Budget Estimates hearings enable open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability through the scrutiny of government spending and agency performance to ensure accountability. By extension, the drafting of answers to Questions on Notice (QON) and Questions Taken on Notice (QTONs) contain information relating to subjects where further detail is sought on important issues to inform debate. In making my decision, I have also considered that a significant amount of the information sought is publicly available on the ACT Legislative Assembly website in the form of final signed answers, and the advancement of public interest lies with the disclosure of additional government information contained within the drafts and relevant correspondence. I have attributed moderate weight to these factors.

Factors favouring nondisclosure (Schedule 2.2)

- *Section 2.2(a)(ii) - prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the Human Rights Act 2004.*
- *Section 2.2(a)(xvi) - prejudice a deliberative process of government.*

In reviewing the information in scope of your application, the personal information of CED and the staff of Ministerial Offices was identified. This information includes mobile numbers of CED and Ministerial Office staff, which are either personal phone numbers or provided by to staff for a specific reason. Where the number is provided for work purposes, the use of the is for agreed purposes only, with limitations on calls outside of business hours. Disclosure of these contact numbers is likely to prejudice the personal privacy of employees and their right to disconnect. As such, I find that the disclosure of this information would prejudice their right to privacy under the *Humans Rights Act 2004* and find that the protection of an individual's right to privacy carries significant weight.

I have also identified information within records 145, 146, 147, 148, 154 and 155 as containing some information which relates to a current government deliberative process. The information relates to a current procurement process, and the disclosure of the information at this time is likely to prejudice the process. I find that potential harm to the process carries significant weight.

Balancing the factors

As detailed above, I have attributed moderate weight to the factors favouring disclosure and in limited instances identified information which is personal information or information relating to a current government deliberative process. In balancing the factors, I find that the disclosure of the information which is personal information or information relating to a current government deliberative process is, on balance, contrary to the public interest.

Consistent with the pro-disclosure intent of the FOI Act, I am satisfied that redacting only the information that is contrary to the public interest ensures compliance with the FOI Act while still providing access to the majority of the information held by CED within the scope of your application.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this application because the fee has been waived in accordance with section 107 of the FOI Act.

Online publishing – Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, CED maintains a disclosure log, which is a public record of access applications and decisions. Your original access application and my decision will be published on the CED disclosure log. Your personal contact details will not be published.

ACT Ombudsman Review

My decision on your access application is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the FOI Act. You have the right to seek ACT Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the FOI Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is provided to you, or a longer period allowed by the ACT Ombudsman.
