I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 31 August 2018, in which you sought access to:

- CCTV review of camera/s at [REDACTED] of [REDACTED] for the afternoon [REDACTED]

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

TCCS is required to provide a decision on your access application by 28 September 2018.

#### **Decision on access**

A search of TCCS records has failed to identify any CCTV footage in relation to your request. The search was conducted by Libraries ACT using the information you provided, and [REDACTED] confirmed that [REDACTED] the footage on the date you have requested is unable to be recovered.

I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no footage relevant to your request is held by TCCS.

#### **Charges**

Processing charges are not applicable for this request because no documents are being released to you.
