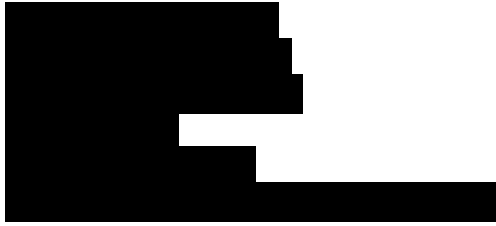

Freedom of Information Request - Reference 24-076

I refer to your application for access to government information received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 17 May 2024 seeking the following government information under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016 (the Act)*:

'The TCCS Priority Footpath List as at November 2023'

Timeframes

A decision on your access application is due on 2 July 2024.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

Decision on access

In January this year a similar request was processed by TCCS, reference 24-010. In the processing of your application, it was identified that the list you are seeking access to is the same released in full under the previous access application. As the record is identical, I have processed your application in accordance with section 43 (d) of the FOI Act, as the relevant government information is already available to you via the link above.

Ombudsman review
