3. Any communications between Minister Berry's office and the Suburban Land Agency, ACT Planning Authority, or City Renewal Authority regarding the Phillip site between 1 July 2022 and the present day (17 April 2026 or whenever this request is received).

4. Any communications between Minister Berry's office and the ACT Electoral Commission or ACT Labor regarding political donations received from Nick Georgalis, Geocon Group, or associated entities between 1 January 2018 and present day.
