Good afternoon,

Thank you for processing the recent FOIs. I very much appreciate your help getting to the bottom of how, why and who constructed a car park on the Lyneham Neighbourhood Oval.

I really do apologise for draining so much of your time and resources.

There is, unfortunately, a considerable gap in the documents that the ACT government has released.

So far, the TCCS, CMTEDD and EPSDD have been unable to provide any documents regarding the actual development/sealing of the car park in late 2016, or even the existence of the sealed car park.

The documents that the ACT Government have released span right up until late 2016 (directly before the car park was sealed). These documents provide evidence that the ACT government determined that the BCC were **not** successful in gaining a direct sale of the site, for the purpose of developing a sealed car park, and that BCC **did not** have permission to seal a car park on the site.

The FOIs to date have been able to confirm that:

- The Brindabella Christian College sublease a part of block 23, section 41, Lyneham from the crown. The sublease commenced on the 1st of May 2009, for the purpose of "outdoor sports facility and ancillary thereto car parking" (refer to Item 9, Schedule 1, of the sublease). Section 8 and Schedule 1 of the sublease clearly states that the site can only be used for an 'Outdoor Sports Facility and ancillary thereto car parking', and that no other development is permitted (section 8.1 and 8.2 of the sub lease).
- The TCCS FOI (22-146) confirmed that no further records are held by TCCS in regards to an agreement that would allow the Brindabella Christian College permission to use block 23, section 41, Lyneham for the purposes of a car park.
- The TCCS FOI (22-146), EPSDD FOI (22/142874) and FOI EPSDD 19/28355 confirmed that the BCC sought a development exemption, to seal the car park, and sought a direct sale of the site in 2016 for the purpose of sealing the car park. However the TCCS FOI (22-146), EPSDD FOI (22/142874) confirmed that neither a relevant development application for the car park development, nor a direct sale of land proceeded. The TCCS FOI (22-146) confirmed that as neither process went ahead, an amended or new sublease for Brindabella Christian College was not pursued.

Despite the direct sale falling through, and after the college was told that they would NOT be exempt from needing a development approval if they wanted to seal the car park, the car park was sealed anyway, in late 2016.

All the current evidence indicates that the car park was developed by and for the Brindabella Christian College.

The main record keeping issue is that the TCCS are the custodians of the site. The land is reserved under s315 of the planning and development legislation and has a plan of management in place. They have been given the <u>administrative responsibility</u> for this public land, with Minister Steel as the responsible Minister for the custodianship of the site. The TCCS FOI (22-146) was able to confirm this.


Considering that the ACT Government (TCCS) are the custodians of this public land, it's reasonable to assume that TCCS, CMTEDD or EPSDD must have some correspondence or awareness regarding the use of the site. They must have been aware of the sealing/development of the car park in late 2016, and the existence of the sealed car park on the site.

It could not have just appeared without the ACT Government having any awareness, especially considering the extensive relevant correspondence and discussion amongst the government in the 5 years directly leading up to the development of the car park.


If the ACT Government genuinely had no awareness of the car park development, this is alarming and may indicate mis-management of the public land.

Furthermore, the ACTmapi land custodian map has been updated with the boundary of the car park distinguished from the remaining recreational public land area of block 23, (aka block 27), section 41, Lyneham. This strongly implies that the ACT Government has some awareness about the location of the car park, and that it exists.

 On the ACTmapi Land Custodian map, it states that the part of block 23 (represented as block 27) is managed by TCCS Roads ACT on the custodian map. This is the site of a car park development that the Lynegam community is seeking information about.



 The remainder of block 23 (aka block 27) is managed by TCCS Sport and Recreation Facilities on the custodian map.



This FOI is seeking:

- Any documents or correspondence held by TCCS, EPSDD or CMTEDD between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018 regarding the development and/or the existence of a car park on block 23, (or also known as block 27), section 41, Lyneham.
- O Any documents or correspondence held by TCCS, EPSDD or CMTEDD between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018 regarding Brindabella Christian Colleges use of the site (block 23, aka block 27, section 41, Lyneham), including correspondence with Brindabella Christian College.
- Any other documents or correspondence regarding the use of block 23, section 41 (or also known as block 27, section 41), Lyneham, between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018, including correspondence with other ACT Government agencies.
- o If the car park was sealed as a public car park by or for the ACT Government, it would be reasonable to assume that some design plans, contracts, tenders, Works as Executed (WAE), drawings, AP diagrams, handover maintenance plans, public Infrastructure project minutes, file notes or some planning, public Infrastructure and/or maintenance discussions would have occurred. Please share any documents regarding the development and existence of the car park between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018.

The Lyneham community are trying to understand how and why a dangerous car park was developed on a section of public land, and to what extent the ACT government were aware of the development.

Please let me know if no documents exist. I really do apologise for the persistent requests, and hope that this can be the final request.

Thank you, I am genuinely sorry to be asking so much and for being so persistent. My aim is to keep the community safe and protect public land.





Freedom of Information Request - Reference 23-002

I refer to your application for access to government information received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 16 January 2023. It is my understanding that you are seeking access to the following government information:

- Any documents or correspondence held by TCCS, EPSDD or CMTEDD between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018 regarding the development and/or the existence of a car park on block 23, (or also known as block 27), section 41, Lyneham.
- Any documents or correspondence held by TCCS, EPSDD or CMTEDD between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018 regarding Brindabella Christian Colleges use of the site (block 23, aka block 27, section 41, Lyneham), including correspondence with Brindabella Christian College.
- Any other documents or correspondence regarding the use of block 23, section 41 (or also known as block 27, section 41), Lyneham, between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018, including correspondence with other ACT Government agencies.
- If the car park was sealed as a public car park by or for the ACT Government, it would be reasonable to assume that some design plans, contracts, tenders, Works as Executed (WAE), drawings, AP diagrams, handover maintenance plans, public Infrastructure project minutes, file notes or some planning, public Infrastructure and/or maintenance discussions would have occurred. Please share any documents regarding the development and existence of the car park between the dates of June 2016 till December 2018.

Timeframes

TCCS was required to decide on your application by 14 February 2023. I thank you for agreeing to an extension to 3 March 2023.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

Decision on access

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search of TCCS records has been completed and 7 records have been identified as relevant to your application.

Upon reviewing the information within the records and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have decided to provide you with partial access to these records.

The records identified as relevant to your application are listed in the schedule enclosed at Attachment A. A copy of the records with is enclosed at Attachment B.

Statement of Reasons

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act; and
- The Human Rights Act 2016.

In making my decision on disclosing the relevant government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 and 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies.

Schedule 1:

• No relevant sections identified.

Schedule 2:

Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Section 2.1)

- Section 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability; and
- Section 2.1(a)(viii) reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision.

Factors favouring non-disclosure (Section 2.2)

• Section 2.2(a)(ii) - prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the Human Rights Act 2016.

In reviewing the relevant records, personal information relating to third parties, including information which is likely to identify a third party, has been identified. This includes the names of some members of the Committee of the Lyneham Community Association. While the names of these members were publicly available at the time when the records were created, there is currently no information that is publicly available to confirm that these individuals are still members. I have considered that this information is not readily available to the public and the disclosure of this information is likely to prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy under the Human Rights Act 2004 and carries significant weight. In this instance, I have found the disclosure of personal information to be, on balance, contrary to the public interest.

I have found that the factors favouring disclosure can be satisfied with the deletion of information which is contrary to the public interest. A copy of the relevant information is enclosed at Attachment B.

Charges

In accordance with <u>Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2018</u>, a fee of \$0.35 per page of information disclosed, except for the first 50 pages, may be applied to an access application. As the total number of pages in your application does not exceed the fee-free threshold, a fee is not relevant.

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application, my decision and documents will be published in the TCCS disclosure log between 3-10 business days from the date of this decision. My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek an Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in TCCS' disclosure log or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.

Advice from EPSD is that:

This seems more a matter between the sub-lessee and sub-lessor.

If there is a sublease between Sport and Rec and BCC, and Sport and Rec wanted our view on how to interpret this matter, we would generally say the following.

A lease (or by extension a sublease) might provide for a particular purpose (the dominant purpose) and an ancillary purpose might also be allowed. If the dominant purpose does not proceed, then the ancillary purpose also cannot proceed. Hence, the ancillary purpose cannot operate in the absence of an active dominant purpose.

Can you please advise if you accept and if so let me know if you want any other input from us.

Re: Breach of sub-lease by Brindabella Christian College

We wish to draw your attention to an apparent breach by Brindabella Christian College of the sub-lease they hold over part of Lyneham Neighbourhood Oval.

The sub-lease is administered by Sport and Recreation Facilities, and covers the portion of the PRZ1-zoned Lyneham Neighbourhood Oval designated "Area 1". The clearly noted purpose of the sub-lease is for:

"outdoor sports facility and ancillary thereto car parking".

The only purpose to which the land in question is currently being used is for car parking for the school. There is no outdoor sports facility, and never has been. Clearly the sub-lease purpose requires that the car parking be ancillary to a sports facility. It follows then that if there is no sports facility, there can be no car parking under the sub-lease conditions.

Therefore, by using the sub-leased land for car parking (not ancillary to an outdoor sports facility), Brindabella Christian College is in breach of the sub-lease.

Given that Brindabella Christian College is in breach of the sub-lease, we request that the sub-lease be terminated immediately.

The sub-lease is administered by Sport and Recreation Facilities, and covers the portion of the PRZ1-zoned Lyneham Neighbourhood Oval designated "Area 1". The clearly noted purpose of the sub-lease is for:

"outdoor sports facility and ancillary thereto car parking".

The only purpose to which the land in question is currently being used is for car parking for the school. There is no outdoor sports facility, and never has been. Clearly the sub-lease purpose requires that the car parking be ancillary to a sports facility. It follows then that if there is no sports facility, there can be no car parking under the sub-lease conditions.

Therefore, by using the sub-leased land for car parking (not ancillary to an outdoor sports facility), Brindabella Christian College is in breach of the sub-lease.

Given that Brindabella Christian College is in breach of the sub-lease, we request that the sub-lease be terminated immediately.
