### **Freedom of Information Request - Reference 25-043**

I refer to your application for access to government information received by the City and Environment Directorate (CED) on 18 August 2025, where you are seeking access to the following government information under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act):

*“Ministerial Brief Titles from 22 May 2025 to 18 August 2025 provided by CED to all applicable Ministers”.*

#### **Timeframes**

In accordance with section 40 of the FOI Act, a decision was initially due on 29 September 2025. I thank you for granting an extension until 14 October 2025.

#### **Authority**

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

#### **Decision on access**

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search of CED records has been completed, and 246 Ministerial Brief Titles have been identified and have been compiled into one document.

Upon reviewing the information identified in the record, I have found that some of the information within the document is, on balance, contrary to the public interest to disclose. I have decided to provide you with:

- Full access to two-hundred and twenty-two (222) Ministerial Brief Titles
- Partial access to two Ministerial Brief Titles
- Refused access to twenty-two (22) Ministerial Brief Titles.

My decision is detailed further in the following statement of reasons. The requested information provided at Attachment A with deletions applied to information which is contrary to the public interest to disclose.

#### **Statement of Reasons**

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- the FOI Act;
- the content of the documents that fall within the scope of your request; and
- the *Human Rights Act 2004*.

The FOI Act has a pro disclosure bias, which requires information to be disclosed unless doing so would be contrary to the public interest. As an Information Officer, I must decide where,

on balance, public interest lies in the disclosure of government information. Section 17 (1) of the FOI Act sets out the steps for completing the public interest test. As part of this process, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 of the FOI Act. If no factor in schedule 1 is found relevant, I must then consider the factors listed in schedule 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies.

#### **Schedule 1**

- Schedule 1.6(1)(a) Cabinet information - that has been submitted, or that a Minister proposes to submit, to Cabinet for its consideration and that was brought into existence for that purpose
- Schedule 1.2 Information subject to legal professional privilege - Information that would be privileged from production or admission into evidence in a legal proceeding on the ground of legal professional privilege.
- Schedule 1.14(1)(a) Law enforcement or public safety information - prejudice the investigation of a contravention or possible contravention of the law in a particular case

#### **Public interest test (Schedule 2)**

##### Factors favouring disclosure (Schedule 2.1)

- Schedule 2.1(a)(i) - promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability.
- Schedule 2.1(a)(ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest.

##### Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2.2)

- Section 2.2 (a)(ii) – prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2004*.

In my consideration of factors favouring non-disclosure of information within the records, I have identified the personal information of parties who are not employees of the ACT Government. This information includes the names of members of the public. I have considered that the information has been provided to CED with the expectation that it is handled in accordance with published privacy statements and policies. I consider that this information is not readily available to the public and has not otherwise been disclosed by CED. I further consider that this information has come to be held by CED with the expectation that it is handled in accordance with the *Information Privacy Act 2014*.

I have found that the factors favouring disclosure can be satisfied by the deletion of information which is contrary to the public interest. I have attached a list of the records at Attachment A and a copy of the records with redactions enclosed at Attachment B.

#### **Charges**

No fee is applicable to this application as the number of pages does not exceed the fee-free threshold.

#### **Online publishing – disclosure log**

Under section 28 of the Act, CED maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application, my decision and documents released to you will be published within 3 – 10 business days. Your personal information will be deleted from these copies prior to publication.

**Ombudsman review**

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in CED's disclosure log or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.
