Under the **Freedom of Information Act 2016 (ACT)**, I am writing to request access to specific statistical data held by **Access Canberra / CMTEDD** regarding the registration of "Item of Plant" entries for Elevators/Lifts. If responsibility for the plant register sits with the City and Environment Directorate (following the 1 July 2025 machinery-of-government changes), please forward this request to the appropriate FOI officer.

Information Requested

I am seeking de-identified, aggregate statistical data (no personal owner names required) for the period **1 January 2008 to 31 December 2025**, or for the longest portion of that period for which the regulator holds records. A breakdown by year would be ideal.

1. The total number of registered "Item of Plant" entries for lifts (passenger / residential) installed at a residential premises during each year of the period.
2. **Segmentation:** A breakdown where the "Type of Installation" or "Category of Use" is classified as "**Private Residence**", "**Single Dwelling**", "**Domestic**", "**Class 1a**", or "**Class 2 sole-occupancy unit**".
3. **Postcode or LGA breakdown (preferred but optional):** A count of these residential registrations grouped by postcode or Local Government Area to identify regional growth trends. This is supplementary and #1 is the primary request.
4. **Site addresses (if releasable):** I understand owner names and any personal information are protected and not sought. However, if the registered installation **address** itself can be released as non-personal information (since residential property addresses are public records via the relevant State Land Registry), I would welcome that data.

Purpose of Request

This data is requested for market research and industry safety analysis to understand the growth of vertical transport in private Australian homes. [REDACTED] is conducting a national study to support safety advocacy, industry capacity planning, and consumer education. We do not require any private information protected under the relevant Privacy Acts.

I understand the ACT FOI Act allows processing free of charge up to a threshold. Please advise if any processing fee is anticipated or further clarification is required.
