Freedom of information request: Our reference – 20-023

I refer to your application made under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act), received by Transport Canberra and City Services Directorate (TCCS) on 19 March 2020 in which you sought access to:

- results concerning vehicle traffic and traffic surveys in Reid ACT in the last two years (March 2018 to March 2020); and
- the number of motor vehicle accidents said to have occurred at the corner of Curong St (Sth) and Euree Street, Reid in the past two years.

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

TCCS is required to provide a decision on your access application by 27 April 2020.

Decision on access

Officers from Roads have identified only one traffic speed survey undertaken in Reid over the past two years. The number of motor vehicle accidents reported at the corner of Curong Street and Euree Street have also been identified.

I have provided you with full access to this data at [Attachment A](#).

Release of the information is in the public interest as it informs the community of the process followed by government in relation to the assessment process for improvements on our roads as part of the ACT Road Safety Improvement Program. It also improves the Directorate's accountability for decisions it makes by being transparent in releasing the information.

Charges

No fee is payable as the number of pages being released is within the fee-free threshold.


