Freedom of Information Request - Reference 22-007

I refer to your application for access to government information received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 20 January 2022. It is my understanding that you are seeking access to the following government information under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016*:

"I would like to know if there have been any complaints about the footpath outside 364 Fairbairn Avenue, Pialligo, ACT, 2609 from 1 January to 30 October 2021."

A decision is due on your access application by 18 February 2022.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

Decision on access

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search of TCCS records has been completed. This search identified 3 records as relevant to your application.

Upon reviewing the information within the records, and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have decided to provide you with:

- Full access to 1 record; and
- Partial access to 2 records.

The reasons for my decision are provided below under the heading 'statement of reasons'.

The documents are listed in the schedule at <u>Attachment A</u>, and a copy of the records with deletions applied to the information I have found to be contrary to the public interest is at <u>Attachment B</u>.

Statement of Reasons

In making my decision on disclosing government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies. In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Schedule 2, Section 2.1)

- Schedule 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability;
- Schedule 2.1(a)(viii) reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision;
- Schedule 2.1(a)(xi) reveal environmental or health risks or measures relating to public health and safety.

Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2, Section 2.2)

• Schedule 2.2(a)(ii) - prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2016*.

In reviewing the relevant records, personal information relating to third parties has been identified. This includes medical, employment and personal identifying information. I have considered that the disclosure of this information is likely to prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy under the *Human Rights Act 2004 and* carries significant weight. In this instance, I have found the disclosure of personal information to be, on balance, contrary to the public interest.

I have found that the factors favouring disclosure can be satisfied by the deletion of information which is contrary to the public interest. A copy of the relevant information is enclosed at Attachment B.

Charges

No fees are applicable to this application as the information being provided to you is within the fee free threshold.

Online publishing - disclosure log

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your access application and my decision will be published on the <u>TCCS Disclosure Log</u> within 3 – 10 business days. Your personal information will be removed from these documents prior to publication.

Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek an Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in TCCS' disclosure log or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.
