I understand that a condition of the permit will be that I, as licensee, shall maintain a register of all animal(s) trapped, released or euthanised. It is a permit requirement that this register be forwarded to the animal welfare authority at the completion of trapping or by no later than 31 July each year.

*If your application is successful, your licence will be subject to the above conditions. A breach of these conditions may lead to the suspension or cancellation of the licence.*

*Please note: Section 7D of the Animal Welfare Regulation 2001 requires that, under section 68 of the Act, ' the authority may, in writing, require a trapping licence-holder to give the authority information in writing or documents that the authority reasonably needs to exercise its function under this Act in relation to the trapping licence'.

*(Animal Welfare Regulation 2001 section 7C prohibits certain traps from use)*
  - what research (if any) will be conducted,
  - the area in which trapping will be conducted (supply a detailed locality map if possible),
  - how trapped animal(s) will be release back into habitat or detail euthanasia method and disposal of carcasses,
  - what actions will be taken in respect to animal(s) injured through trapping,
  - method for excluding non-targeted species,
  - details of trappers experience with the species to be trapped, and
  - details of employees or agents relevant experience.

An inspection may be required to satisfy the Authority in relation to:

- the experience and competency of the applicant in the care and handling of animals;
- the adequacy of the applicant's premises, equipment and other facilities for the handling and care of animals; and
- the criteria as required under subsections 64 (2) and (3) of the Animal Welfare Act 1992.

Ensure the application fee is enclosed. Cheques/money orders should be made payable to "Receivers of Public Monies", or cash payment may be made directly to the Animal Welfare Authority.
