Freedom of Information request: Reference 19-017

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by Chief Ministers, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate (CMTEDD) and transferred to Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 18 February 2019 in which you sought access to:

- A list of maintenance requests on the public footpaths on Watkin Street Bruce, for the period Jan 2017 to Jan 2019.

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

TCCS was required to provide a decision on your access application by 19 March 2019.

Decision on access

A search of TCCS records has failed to identify any documentation in relation to your request. The search was conducted by Roads Maintenance in City Services using the information you provided. I am satisfied that appropriate searches were completed and that no documents relevant to your request are held by TCCS.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable for this request because no documents are being released to you.
