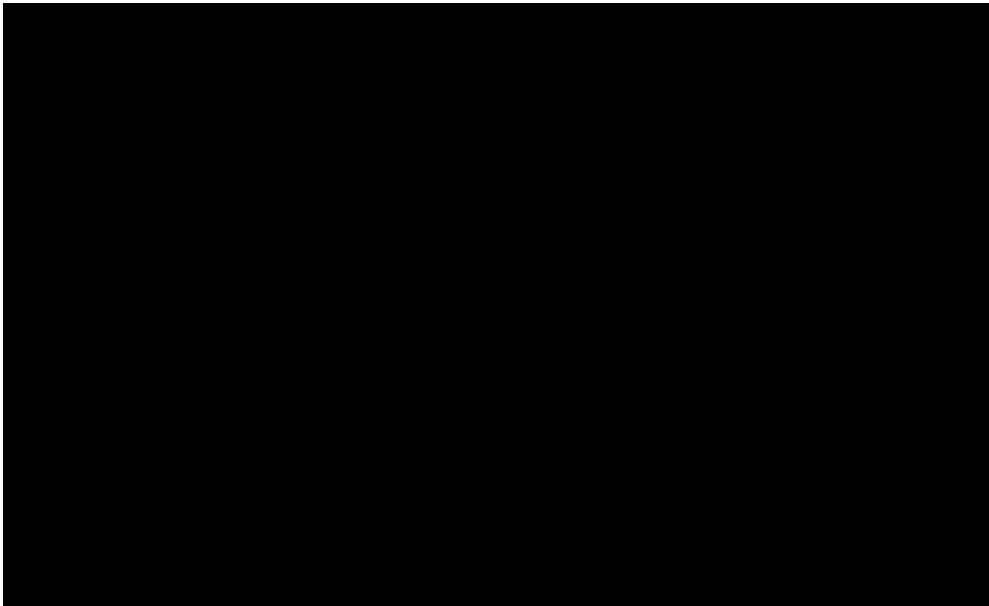

I refer to your application made under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the FOI Act) that was received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 1 September 2022. It is my understanding that you are seeking access to the following information:

“a copy of the results of the November 2021 ACT Public Service Employee Survey, which have been provided to the TCCS Directorate by the Pilot ACTPS Survey team.”

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act.

Timeframes

In accordance with section 40 of the Act, TCCS is required to provide a decision on your access application by 29 September 2022.

Decision on access

A search of information held by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) has been concluded and no documents relevant to your request have been identified. Supported by the fact that TCCS did not participate in the 2021 ACT Public Service Employee Survey, I have decided that the search was sufficient and no information is held by TCCS.

Charges

Pursuant to *Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2018* processing charges are applicable where more than 50 pages are disclosed. No fee is applicable to your application, as no relevant information has been identified.

Disclosure log

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your original access application and my decision will be published on the TCCS disclosure between 3 – 10 days after the date of this decision.

Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in TCCS' disclosure log or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.


ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal (ACAT) review
