# Freedom of Information Request - Reference 23-012

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 27 February 2023 seeking a:

"Listing of Route 4 bus rego numbers that have been dispatched from Tuggeranong to Belconnen since inception of the new timetable 30/1/23 to 14/2/23. Listing of ACT buses that have bike racks. Policies that may be in place to ensure reasonable timeframes between buses that have bike racks".

# Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

# Timeframes

A decision on your application is due by 28 March 2023.

# **Decision on access**

A search of records held by TCCS has been completed and the information from HASTUS as been extracted showing the vehicle registration numbers, timeframes and a list of the buses fitted with/without a bike rack.

Upon reviewing the information within the records and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have decided to provide you with full disclosure of the data available and the list is enclosed at <u>Attachment A</u>.

In relation to your request for a policy that outlines the reasonable timeframes between buses that have bike racks, I have been advised that no such policy exists. In consideration of this advice and the outcome of the record search, I am satisfied that all appropriate searches have been completed. Pursuant to section 35(1)(b) of the Act, I have determined that the information that you have requested is not held by TCCS.

# **Statement of Reasons**

In making my decision on disclosing government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies. In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

# Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Schedule 2, Section 2.1)

- Section 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability; and
- Section 2.1(a)(viii) reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision.

# Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2, Section 2.2)

• No factors favouring non-disclosure were identified as relevant to this application.

I have considered the public interest in relation to information and find that the information enclosed with this notice is in the public interest to disclose in full.

# Charges

No fees are applicable, as the information being provided to you is within the fee free threshold.

# **Online publishing – disclosure log**

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. # Ombudsman review
