I refer to your application received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) by transfer from Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) on 13 July 2023 in which you sought access to information under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the FOI Act).

In your application you have requested information relating to the following documents which may be in possession of the Transport Canberra and City Services directorate:

"For the 2022-2023 financial year, decisions made in relation to requests to remove trees from residential properties in the ACT.

1. Applications made, decisions in relation to those applications and reasons for decisions.

2. Compliance activities undertaken where trees were removed or damaged without permission and resulting fines/penalties applied".

TCCS is now processing your request. In accordance with section 40 of the FOI Act, we must make a decision on your application within 30 working days of receipt, being 24 August 2024. This period may, however, be extended if we need to consult third parties or for other reasons set out in the FOI Act. We will notify you if this is the case. Otherwise , you should expect a decision from us within 3 business days from the date a decision is made . Please contact our office if you do not receive a notice of decision within this timeframe.

Third Party Consultation

In processing your application, consultation with relevant third parties may be required. If this is the case, you will be notified to this effect and advised of a

revised decision due date in respect of your application. In line with the Act, if third party consultation is required, the due date may be extended by 15 working days.

Charges

Should you be liable to pay a processing charge, you will be notified in writing of the preliminary assessment and given an opportunity to make an application that the charge should be remitted in whole or in part. I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) by transfer from the Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate (EPSDD) on 13 July 2023 seeking the following information:

"For the 2022-2023 financial year, decisions made in relation to requests to remove trees from residential properties in the ACT.

1. Applications made, decisions in relation to those applications and reasons for decisions.

2. Compliance activities undertaken where trees were removed or damaged without permission and resulting fines/penalties applied.

On the 31 July 2023 you confirmed agreement to reduce the scope of your application to the number of applications and decisions for residential properties relating to the following four suburbs only:

- Ainslie
- O'Connor
- Dickson; and
- Lyneham

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

Timeframes

A decision on your application is due by 24 August 2023.

Decision on access

Part 1

A search of records held by TCCS has been completed and the requested information has been extracted for the four suburbs.

Upon reviewing the information within the records and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have decided to provide you with full disclosure of the data available. Information to be disclosed to you is listed in the schedule at <u>Attachment A</u> and the documents are enclosed at <u>Attachment B</u>.

Part 2

In relation to the second part of your request, I am advised that there was only one complaint in O'Connor however the fines/penalties were not applied due to insufficient evidence presented to the Tree Protection Unit. In consideration of this advice, and the completed record search I find that all reasonable steps have been exhausted and the requested information is not held by TCCS.

Statement of Reasons

In making my decision on disclosing government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies. In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Schedule 2, Section 2.1)

- Section 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability; and
- Section 2.1(a)(viii) reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision.

Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2, Section 2.2)

• No factors favouring non-disclosure were identified as relevant to this application.

I have considered the public interest in relation to the information and find that the information enclosed with this notice is in the public interest to disclose in full.

Charges

No fees are applicable, as the information being provided to you is within the fee-free threshold.

Online publishing – disclosure log

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. Your access application and this notice of decision will be published on the disclosure log within 3 - 10 business days. Your personal information will be removed from these documents prior to publication.

Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in TCCS' disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.
