Freedom of Information Request - Reference 23-149

I refer to your application for access to government information received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 13 December 2023 under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act). It is my understanding that you are seeking access to the following government information:

"A list of the name of all tenders for the last two years (1/1/2022 - 31/12/22 and 1/1/23 - 13/12/23) where the final decision maker was the Director-General."

Timeframes

A decision is due on your access application by 1 February 2024.

Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

Decision on access

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search was conducted of records held by TCCS. Your scope has been interpreted to include tenders where the Director-General (DG) was the financial delegate who approved entering into a contract with the proposed contractor. The DG may not have been the person who signed the actual contract. These tender titles have been compiled into a format consistent with your application.

In reviewing the information within this document, I have found, on balance, it is in the public interest to provide you with full access to this record. My decision is detailed in the below statement of reasons.

Statement of Reasons

In making my decision on disclosing government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 and 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies. In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

Schedule 1:

• No relevant factors identified

Factors favouring disclosure in the public interest (Schedule 2, Section 2.1)

- Schedule 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability;
- Schedule 2.1(a)(ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest; and

• Schedule 2.1(a)(iii) - inform the community of the government's operations, including the policies, guidelines and codes of conduct followed by the government in its dealings with members of the community.

Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2, Section 2.2)

• No factors were identified as relevant.

Consistent with the FOI Act, I have not identified any factors favouring non-disclosure. I have found that the disclosure of this information is in the public interest and provide you with full access. This relevant record is enclosed at <u>Attachment A.</u>

Charges

No fees are applicable, as the total number of pages are within the fee-free threshold.
