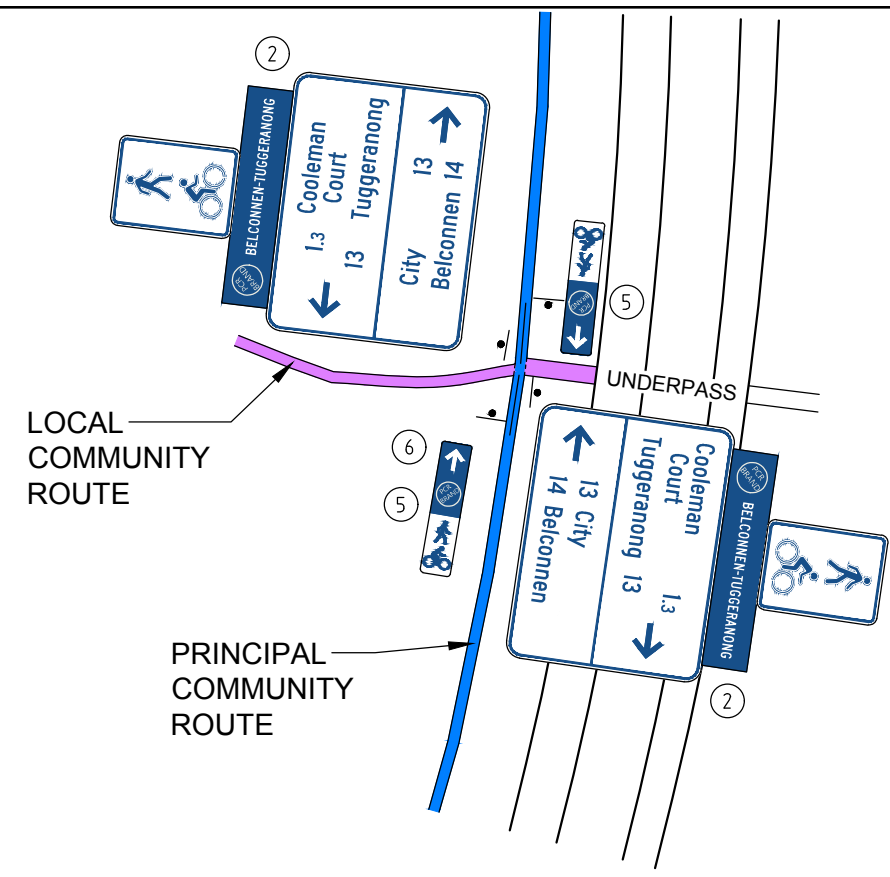
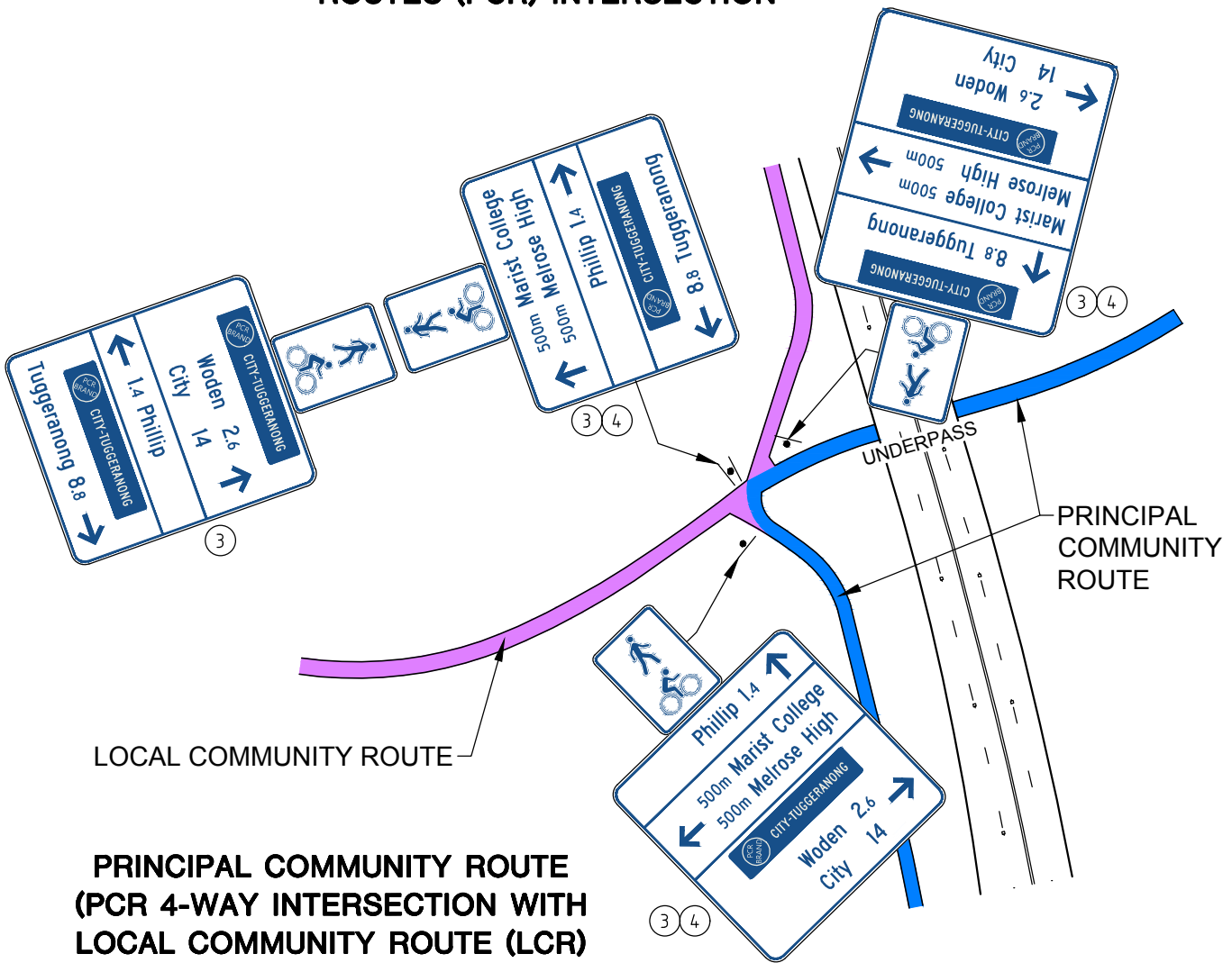


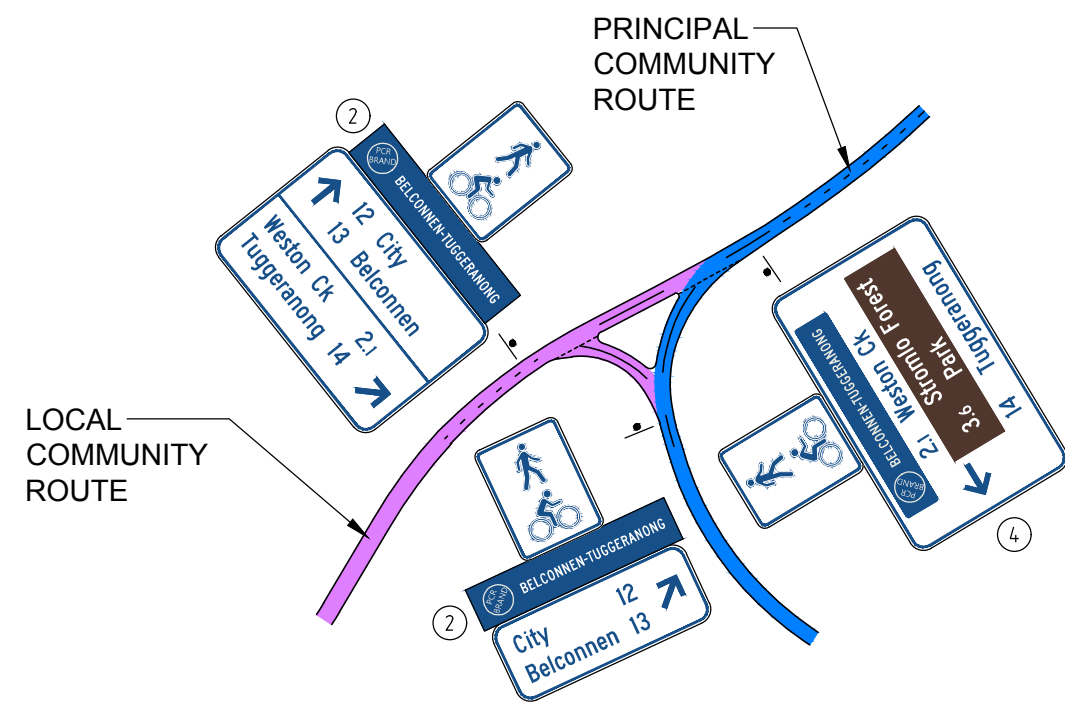
MULTIPLE PRINCIPAL COMMUNITY ROUTES (PCR) INTERSECTION



- 2 WHERE ALL DIRECTIONS SHOWN ON THE DESTINATION SIGN ARE ON THE SAME PCR/PCRS A SEPARATE GC-11 SHOULD BE INSTALLED. LCR DESTINATION SIGNS MAY BE USED INSTEAD OF MCR DESTINATION SIGNS FOR THIS TYPE OF INTERSECTION. REFER TO ACTSD-0591 AND -0593 FOR EXAMPLES
- 3 WHERE A PCR APPLIES TO SOME BUT NOT ALL DIRECTIONS PCR PLATES WILL NEED TO BE INSTALLED
- 4 LOCAL DESTINATIONS MAY BE INCLUDED ON GC-10 AND GC-21 SIGNAGE ON INTERSECTION LEGS, IF MCR/LCRS. REFER TO MIS05 4.10.5 FOR DESTINATIONS THAT MAY BE INCLUDED
- 5 GC-02 SIGNS MAY BE INSTALLED TO PROVIDE REASSURANCE WHEN A DESTINATION SIGN ON THE PCR APPROACH TO KEY DECISION POINTS IS NOT WARRANTED
- 6 LOCAL COMMUNITY ROUTE DESTINATION SIGNS HAVE BEEN OMITTED FOR CLARITY
- 7 PCR BRAND PAVEMENT MARKING HAS BEEN OMITTED FOR CLARITY. REFER TO ACTSD-0575 FOR BRANDS AND INSTALLATION DETAILS
