
We request access to the following government information under the *Freedom of Information Act 2016*:




### AUTHORITY TO ACT

#### Freedom of Information Request - Reference 23-136

I refer to your application for access to government information received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 13 November 2023. It is my understanding that you are seeking access to the following government information:

"All records relating to the maintenance, upkeep, monitoring, and repair of the footpath located on Bradley Street, Phillip including but not limited to spreadsheets, lists, work order memos, Fix My Street submissions, priority designations, complaints, defects, and work order completion records for the period 1 January 2020 to date".

I thank you for providing a copy of authority to act and enclosing a Google Maps image for ease of reference.

#### Timeframes

A decision is due on your access application on 18 January 2024.

#### Authority

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

#### **Decision on access**

In accordance with the FOI Act, a search of TCCS records which are accessible has been completed and ten records have been identified as relevant to your application.

Upon reviewing the information within the records and applying the public interest test under section 17 of the FOI Act, I have decided to provide you with:

- Full access to six records; and
- Partial access to four records.

The records identified as relevant to your application are listed in the schedule enclosed at <u>Attachment A</u>. A copy of the records with deletions applied to the information I have found to be contrary to the public interest is enclosed at <u>Attachment B</u>.

#### **Statement of Reasons**

In making my decision on disclosing the relevant government information, I must identify all relevant factors in schedule 1 and 2 of the FOI Act and determine, on balance, where the public interest lies. I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act; and
- The Human Rights Act 2016.

#### Schedule 1:

• No relevant sections identified.

#### Schedule 2:

#### Factors favouring disclosure (Schedule 2.1)

- Schedule 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability.
- Schedule 2.1(a)(iv) ensure effective oversight of expenditure of public funds; and
- Schedule 2.1(a)(viii) reveal the reason for a government decision and any background or contextual information that informed the decision.

#### Factors favouring non-disclosure (Schedule 2.2)

• Schedule 2.2(a)(ii) - prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2016*.

In reviewing the relevant records, I have identified personal information of a third party, such as names and contact details. I have considered that this information is not readily available to the public and the disclosure of this information is likely to prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy under the *Human Rights Act 2004*. I have attributed significant weight to this factor and find the disclosure of personal information to be, on balance, contrary to the public interest.

I have found that the factors favouring disclosure can be satisfied with the deletion of information which is contrary to the public interest. A copy of the relevant information is enclosed at <u>Attachment B.</u>

#### Charges

In accordance with <u>Freedom of Information (Fees) Determination 2018</u>, a fee of \$0.35 per page of information disclosed, except for the first 50 pages, may be applied to an access application. No fees are applicable to this application as the number of pages being released are within the fee-free threshold.

#### **Online publishing – disclosure log**

Under section 28 of the Act, TCCS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. In accordance with section 28, your application, my decision and the information disclosed to you will be published within 3 – 10 business days. All personal information will be removed prior to publication. You may view the TCCS' disclosure log here.

#### **Ombudsman review**

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the Act. You have the right to seek an Ombudsman review of this outcome under section 73 of the Act within 20 working days from the day that my decision is published in TCCS' disclosure log, or a longer period allowed by the Ombudsman.

Good morning,

As coincidence would have it, I was inspecting the Phillip area this week, Monday and Tuesday. This quite often happens after I have inspected an area. People see me walking around in my high-vis jacket, logging defects which reminds them of the defects they've been meaning to report. It usually turns out to be the same defect I am logging.

Where we are up to now in the Phillip Town Centre area is that there are 2 work orders in the process of repair at the moment. At the start of business on Monday there were a further 21 work orders including several in Bradley Street, to be packaged and issued to the contractor after negotiating the procurement process. On Tuesday and Yesterday, Wednesday, I raised a further 13 work orders, 3 of which are at multiple locations also in Bradley Street and which will undergo the same packaging process imminently.

Road Maintenance conducts inspections of the pedestrian areas of all of the Town Centers in the ACT regularly.
