Racing Greyhound Controller Licence Application

This is a special licence under Section 39H of the *Domestic Animals Act 2000* and it is valid for one year.

If you had day-to-day control of a greyhound that was registered with an ACT greyhound racing controlling body prior to 30 April 2018, you are considered to hold a racing greyhound controller licence until 30 October 2018, unless you surrender or cancel the licence.

However, if you worked in, or were involved in, greyhound racing in the ACT and received assistance from the Territory in relation to the ending of greyhound racing in the ACT, then you are ineligible to apply for registration of a greyhound as a racing greyhound or seek a racing greyhound controller licence for the period agreed in writing between the Territory and yourself as a condition of the assistance.
