I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (the Act) received by Transport Canberra and City Services (TCCS) on 20 April 2022 seeking:

to obtain a GIPA on the footpath outside 35 Empire Circuit Forrest ACT 2604 – the following information on the footpath:

- a) Is the state of the footpath known to be in a "state of disrepair" by the Government?
- b) Have there been any incidents on that piece of footpath?
- c) Are there any proposed works to be completed on the footpath?

# **Authority**

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General under section 18 of the Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the FOI Act.

A decision on your application is due on 19 May 2022.
